By its very nature, resilience planning is a multi-disciplinary undertaking. You need to understand completely your own operations in their true context and be able to determine how different events will affect the operation and ultimately your ability to survive, adapt, respond and recover. Ultimately, an operation's ability to recover will be determine by human behaviour and it is up to the resilience planner to work out how to influence and enable the correct behaviours that will keep the operation going.
