Course enrolment for all engineering graduate courses will now be **Friday, August 13, 6am ET**. We are moving this date from August 4th since, later in that week, we will be receiving more detailed updates from the government regarding public health measures for the Fall. This information might impact the classroom information and mode of delivery in a subset of graduate courses. Delaying course enrolment will make it possible for graduate units to input more accurate information in the ROSI/ACORN system which is used by students to make decisions about course enrolment for 2021-2022 academic term.

We will post a list of graduate engineering courses that will be offered online prior to **Friday, August 13**. This list will be posted on the departmental course listing website when available (see below).

The course add deadline for Fall and full-year courses is **Monday, September 20** and the fall course drop deadline is **Monday, October 25**.
